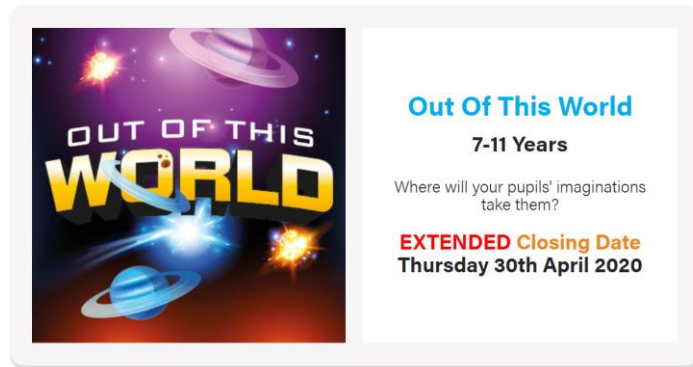


Good morning Primary, make sure you watch your primary staff stars in Newsround today! If you are inspired to be a star yourself then why not enter this poetry competition.
