Then, fill in the planning sheet that will help you to write your poem on Thursday.</p> <p>. Chosen theme – What would you like your poem to be about? It could be about Thomas or fortnite... it's up to you!</p> <p>. Interesting info about my theme – What things could you include in your poem about your theme – for example if it's Thomas, think about what he does, what colour he is etc</p> <p>. Adjectives to include – remember an adjective is a describing word so think – what does the theme of my poem look like? Sound like? Feel like? For Thomas, it could be noisy whistle.</p> <p>. Rhyming pairs – Think of two words that rhyme that link to your theme. For Thomas it could be – train and rain. The more you can think of the easier the final write up on Friday!</p>
