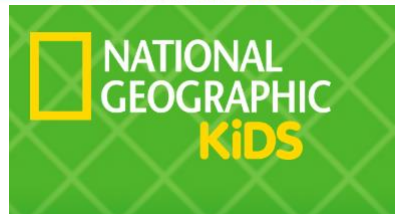


Good morning primary!

As you are off school why not take a look at the Offschool website! There are loads of activities to do including quizzes and weekly competitions.



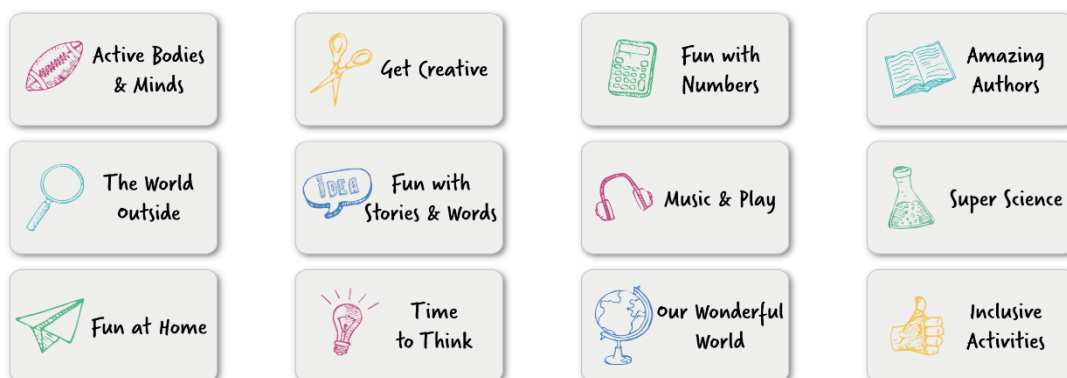
