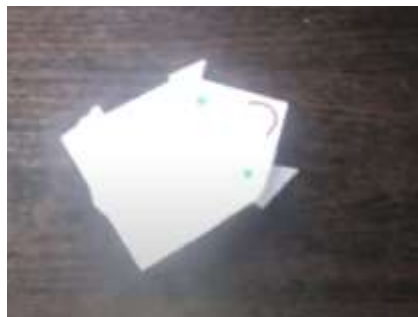


I hope you got on well with your paper spider, Lucy made one and it sat down beside her.
