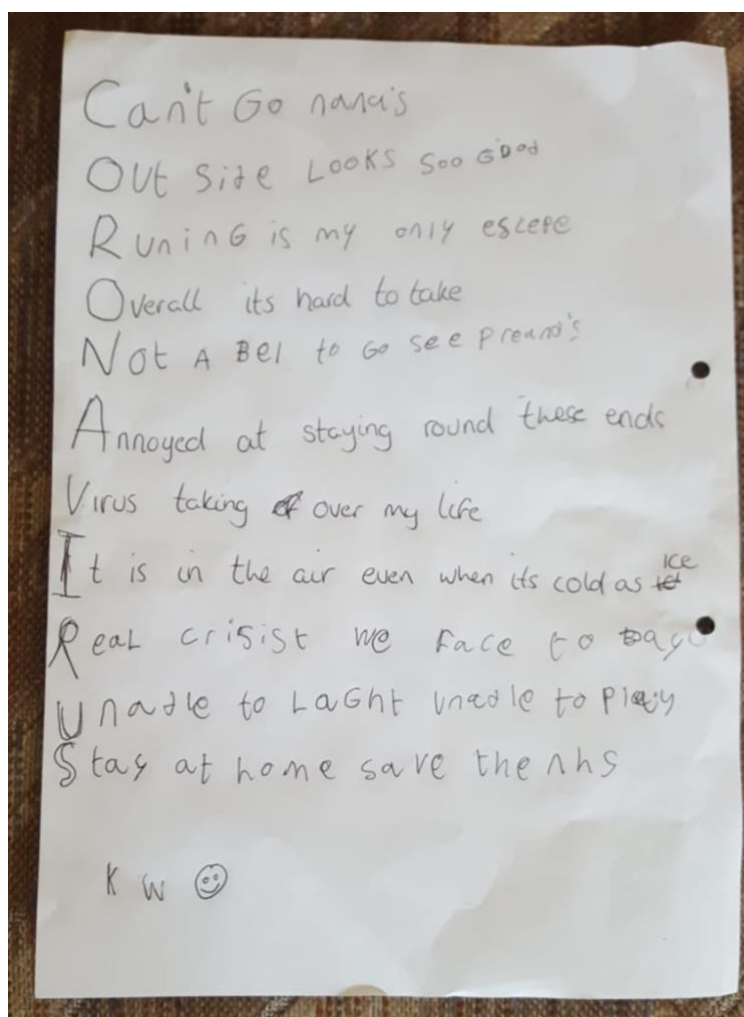


Dear Primary,
